CEO of GalaxE.Solutions Introduces President at Insourcing Forum



At a forum held at the White House this week, “Insourcing American Jobs,” **President Obama** recognized companies who are bringing jobs back to the United States and are contributing to the economy by doing so. **Tim Bryan** chairman and CEO of [GalaxE.Solutions](#) introduced the President, describing the opportunities to ‘put Americans back to work’ and take advantage of the available talent. Bryan’s company has headed the “Outsource to Detroit” program, which has helped establish Detroit as an IT hub that is continuing to create jobs.

In the speech following Bryan’s introduction, the President said: “You also don’t have to be a manufacturer to insource jobs. You just heard Tim, CEO of a health care IT company in New Jersey called GalaxE.Solutions. They’ve already hired 150 workers with their “Outsource to Detroit” program, and they plan on hiring up to 500.”

Along with GalaxE.Solutions, Obama also praised Ford Motor Company for the company’s commitment to investing \$16 million back into the U.S. by 2015, while bringing 2,000 jobs back to Michigan, Missouri, and Ohio.
